Everyday Class Work

The student...

Oral Presentations

- Content: content is accurate; points are clearly made. All evidence supports thesis.
- Coherence and Organization: information is presented in a logical sequence. There is an obvious conclusion summarizing the presentation.
- Grammar: there are few grammatical mistakes or none. Sentences show grammatical variety.
- Vocabulary: word choice is appropriate for the level. Sentences are very descriptive.
- Fluency: speech is natural and effortless; pauses are minimal.
- Speech Delivery: poised, clear articulation; proper volume; steady rate; good posture and eye contact; enthusiasm; confidence.
- Creativity: very original presentation. Captures audience's attention.
- Materials: balanced use of materials, properly employed to develop thesis.
- Timing: maintained time frame.
